SURVIVAL GERMAN gives you a short training in basic grammar and in skills for oral and written communication in academic everyday life.

Target Group:

- Students, PhD students, as well as postdoctoral researchers, with little or no previous knowledge of German, who study and do research in English.
- People interested in acquiring knowledge of basic German. (Good knowledge of the English language is an advantage.)

The *Deutschkurse bei der Universität München e.V.* offers this course in cooperation with the International Office at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University (LMU), Munich.

Participants can be undergraduates, Masters or PhD students, as well as postdoctoral researchers – from **all** Munich universities.

Level:

A1 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) Learners with little or no previous knowledge of German.

- important phrases for everyday communication
- language skills you might need in academic life
- basic vocabulary
- basic principles of grammar
- ways to understand even more difficult texts

For regular attendance (maximum absence 2 times), students can be issued a certificate of participation.
